It doesn't have to be expensive or big, but it must be something that people will want to buy so that it makes money! A winning product/service will be chosen from all of the teams. Saturday Night Challenge**	Students will work in teams; they have to take charge and organise an event within their school on a Saturday night for the local community. They will have to communicate well with their other team members to make this work. They may want to look at what's lacking for young people in their local area. Take Cover – STIXX**	Students will construct a shelter out of STIXX rods that can house two of their team members (if not more). The team must discuss and plan how to construct the shelter. Junior Financial Awareness**	It's never too early to learn the value of money, how much things cost, how to plan and budget, salary expectations for different career paths and how much you need to earn to fund your preferred lifestyle. Our Financial Awareness programme has been developed for students in Year 5/6 and aims to increase student's financial awareness and understanding. A Wild Life!**	Teams will choose different animals to research. This shows that knowing your personality type and what you find engaging might link into future career options where you will be happy and successful in the working world.
