Mock Interviews & Scrap Challenge, Thursday 13th February, 11:45-14:45 Four more volunteers needed

We would love to hear from vocational companies based in the local area who could send some volunteers to help us with a lovely project at High Close School.

In the first half of the day, we will be running Guess My Job with Years 8 & 9. This is a fun and interactive event where you will be interviewed by a small group of students who will try to guess what you do for a living. After student questioning and guessing you will reveal your role and talk about your career journey.

In the afternoon we will support Year 10 & 11 students with their Mock Interviews. For this event, you will be interviewing the students and sharing your expertise with them. These interviews give students the opportunity to put new skills into practice with business professionals, in a supportive and familiar environment. Our aim is to give them a positive experience and leave them feeling positive and optimistic about their future.

Experience of young people with Special Educational Needs is useful but not essential as a full briefing will be given. Ideally, all 7 volunteers will support in both halves of the day to understand the school, but 2 x half-day shifts will be accommodated.
